Congratulations, your child is entering into a new phase of camp life! They are no longer a traditional camper, and are now invited to participate in our Camper in Leadership Training program. The CILT program is one that provides invaluable leadership training to high school aged campers, and is a great opportunity for personal development and growth within a supportive community.

Before entering the CILT program parents, as well as CILT's, must fully understand this program and its goals. Campers entering the 10th grade are invited to participate in this program based on recommendations from their previous summer's Bronco counselors and other unit leaders. Admittance into the program is based upon merit from the previous summer. Although many campers are very interested in participating in this fun and rewarding program, not all campers are invited into the program.

Consequently, enrolling in the CILT program does not mean automatic promotion to the next level. Each year of the CILT program has different requirements (outlined in the "CILT Program Description" enclosed) which must be fulfilled in order to be admitted to the program for the following summer. Our expectations for each CILT level are clear and attainable, and are thoroughly explained to the participating CILTs during camp.

Our selection process considers such attributes as leadership, maturity, self-motivation, responsibility and willingness to accept and follow camp policies and rules. We invite parents and CILTs to visit with us prior to enrollment in the CILT program, in order to facilitate better understanding of our expectations and goals which we hope to reach together with your child.
